ORDER ALLOWING AGREED TAX CLAIMS

The Receiver of International Underwriters Insurance Company in Liquidation ("IUIIC") has moved the Court for an Order allowing agreed tax claims against the estate pursuant to 18 Del. C. § 5917(d).

The Claimants have supplied the Receiver with their written consent to the recommended value and priority classification for these three claims.

NOW, THEREFORE, this 16TH day of June, 2000, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. the tax claim of the Texas Department of Insurance, being represented by the Texas State Comptroller of Public Accounts, is hereby allowed as a Tax Priority (Class 3) claim in the amount of \$13,822.00 in the above-captioned estate;

2. the tax claim of the City of Dallas is hereby allowed as a Tax Priority (Class 3) claim in the amount of \$1,287.32 in the above-captioned estate;

3. the tax claim of the County of Dallas is hereby allowed as a Tax Priority (Class 3) claim in the amount of \$287.83 in the above-captioned estate; and

4. there is no just reason for delay and, therefore, this Order is entered as a final judgment pursuant to Court of Chancery Rule 54(b).
